

Recognised Legal Representatives Ruling 5

1. The following present or former police officers known in the Inquiry by their 'N' ciphers have applied for the designation of Scott Ingram of Slater and Gordon UK LLP as their recognised legal representative under rules 6 and 7 of the Inquiry Rules 2006: N10, N14, N15, N16, N26, N58, N81, N104, N123 and N519.
2. The requirements of rules 6 and 7 were discussed in the first Recognised Legal Representatives Ruling of 9 November 2015 at paragraphs 7 – 10. I was unable to make any decision at that stage as to representation of these officers since representation was not in all cases settled. Representation has now been settled. For reasons that appear in the first Core Participants Ruling of 21 October 2015, paragraphs 25 and 28, these core participants have a similar interest in the subject matter and outcome of the Inquiry that, conveniently, can be represented by a single joint recognised legal representative.
3. I shall therefore designate Scott Ingram as the recognised legal representative in the Inquiry for the above-ciphered core participants.
