

PENAL NOTICE

IF ANY PERSON DISOBEYS THIS ORDER, THE MATTER MAY BE CERTIFIED TO THE HIGH COURT WHICH MAY HOLD THAT PERSON TO BE IN CONTEMPT OF THE INQUIRY AND THAT PERSON MAY BE IMPRISONED, FINED OR HAVE THEIR ASSETS SEIZED

ANY PERSON WHO KNOWS OF THIS ORDER AND DOES ANYTHING WHICH HELPS OR PERMITS ANY PERSON TO BREACH THE TERMS OF THIS ORDER MAY ALSO AFTER CERTIFICATION TO THE HIGH COURT BE HELD TO BE IN CONTEMPT OF THE INQUIRY AND MAY BE IMPRISONED, FINED OR HAVE THEIR ASSETS SEIZED

(1) DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE INQUIRIES ACT 2005

(2) RESTRICTION ORDER UNDER SECTION 19 OF THE INQUIRIES ACT 2005

UPON the Chairman having considered an application dated 30 June 2016, together with its supporting evidence, by the Metropolitan Police Service for a restriction order preventing direct or indirect disclosure of the true identity of a serving police officer here described as 'Cairo'

AND UPON the Chairman being satisfied, for the reasons given in his open and closed rulings dated 19 July 2016, that there would be an unacceptable risk of death or serious injury to Cairo and others in the event of the disclosure of Cairo's real identity

AND UPON the Chairman considering his power to make a restriction order under s.19(2)(b) of the Inquiries Act 2005 read with s.19(3)(b) thereof, and to direct the procedure and conduct of the Inquiry under 17(1) of the Inquiries Act 2005 read with s.17(3) thereof

IT IS DIRECTED THAT the Chairman's closed ruling dated 19 July 2016 shall be disclosed only to:


- a. certain members of the Inquiry team, the identities of whom shall be determined by the Chairman in advance of their seeing the document;
- b. Cairo;

- c. certain employees of the Metropolitan Police Service, the identities of whom shall be determined by the Metropolitan Police Service and notified to the Inquiry in advance of their seeing the document;
- d. certain members of the Counsel team instructed by the Metropolitan Police Service, the identities of whom shall be determined by the Metropolitan Police Service and notified to the Inquiry in advance of their seeing the document.

AND IT IS ORDERED THAT until further order

- 1. This order binds all persons (whether acting by themselves or by their servants or agents or in any other way) and all companies (whether acting by their directors or officers, servants, agents, or in any other way).
- 2. There shall be no direct or indirect disclosure of Cairo's true identity (including any description or image capable of identifying Cairo).
- 3. There shall be no disclosure of the evidence in support of the application dated 30 June 2016 (described at paragraph 8 of the open ruling dated 19 July 2016).
- 4. This order does not prohibit any disclosure or publication to certain members of the Inquiry team, the identities of whom shall be determined by the Chairman in advance of their seeing the document;
- 5. Any person affected by any of the restrictions set out in paragraph 2 above may apply to the Chairman to vary this order.
