

Extracts from email exchanges between HN321 and David Reid (Metropolitan Police Service risk assessor) dated February 2017

“To make matters clear, I am prepared to attend open court and give evidence to the Inquiry, answer direct questions from the Chairman and other Counsel, provided that my identity and current location are not revealed.”

“The only consequence of my declining to appear before the Inquiry would appear to be my possible arrest for contempt of court, if I tried to re-enter the United Kingdom to visit family and friends. That is a sad prospect, but one that I will accept rather than be made a public scapegoat for doing my duty, which was deemed to be legal at the time.”
