

## Recognised Legal Representatives Ruling 13

1. The designated legal representative of the Metropolitan Police Service, Hugh Giles, left the MPS at the end of 2017 and has been replaced by Melanie Jones. I shall designate her the recognised legal representative of the Metropolitan Police Service with effect from 1 January 2018.
2. On or about 3 November 2017 Neil Todd of Thompsons Solicitors replaced Spencer Wood of OH Parsons as the solicitor for the Union of Construction Allied Trades and Technicians ('UCATT'). I shall designate Neil Todd as the recognised legal representative of UCATT with effect from 3 November 2017.
3. On or about 16 November 2017 Dr Donal O'Driscoll withdrew his instructions from Stefano Ruis of Hickman and Rose. He was entitled to do so. Accordingly, as from 16 November 2017 I shall cease to recognise Stefano Ruis as the designated legal representative of Dr O'Driscoll.
4. In Core Participant Ruling 15 of 24 January 2018 I terminated HN123's designation as a core participant in accordance with his wishes. Scott Ingram of Slater and Gordon was recognised as HN123's legal representative in the ruling dated 15 April 2016. HN123 has applied for Scott Ingram no longer to be recognised as his legal representative. HN123 is entitled to act as he chooses. Scott Ingram will no longer be recognised as HN123's legal representative.
