Applications for restriction orders in respect of the real and cover names of officers of the Special Operations Squad and the Special Demonstration Squad

Directions following publication of Minded to Note 6

1. The Inquiry has considered applications received in respect of 17 further individual officers. I am minded to make or to refuse to make restriction orders under section 19(3) of the Inquiries Act 2005 in the cases specified in the table below.
2. In respect of the officers HN33, HN65, HN78, HN80, HN90 and HN112 where I am minded to refuse all or part of their application, the applicants should provide notification that they wish to be heard in a closed hearing by **4pm on Tuesday 10th April 2018** with any written skeleton argument setting out their objections to be provided by **4pm on Tuesday 17th April 2018**.
3. I will issue further directions permitting any core participant who wishes to take issue with the restriction orders I am minded to grant to do so once the open applications and, where applicable, open evidence has been published.
