Would not have undertaken any of this work had I known that my identity might be made public. Some family have very limited knowledge of professional activity; most have no knowledge at all. Been deployed as part of operations in which use of undercover tactics was never disclosed. Believes that disclosure of real name or cover identity will put officer and officer's family at real risk of physical harm. Has no doubt, and in some cases knows, that people wish to seek retribution against officer for sentences of imprisonment received as a result of officer's work. Even if this risk were never to materialise, knows that it would cause great stress and fear for officer and family. [REDACTED]

Has no doubt that the combined knowledge of different targets would be sufficient to identify officer should cover name be disclosed. Disclosure would pose a risk to on-going and future operations.
