Application for a restriction order in respect of the real name of HN104

HN104

1. The mother of HN104's two children by his first marriage is of the view that further information about HN104's post-Special Demonstration Squad police career is relevant to the stance of the non-police, non-state core participants about publication of his real name. This view is based upon the wording of paragraph 7 of the written submissions made by the non-police, non-state core participants dated 6 November 2017. I will allow her this opportunity to attempt to protect the interest of her children. HN104 has now provided a one-page statement describing his post-Special Demonstration Squad police career until his retirement on 20 April 2018. This statement will be provided to the non-state core participants today, so that they can advise the Inquiry whether this changes their stance. Their solicitor should report the outcome to the Inquiry by 4:00pm on 23 July 2018. Further submissions are not required. I will make a decision based upon the submissions which I have already received and the outcome of any further discussions.
