Costs of Legal Representation Awards Ruling 18

'Sara'

1. I have today designated 'Sara' as a core participant in category [H]. She applies for the designation of Harriet Wistrich as her recognised legal representative. I shall so designate her.
2. Harriet Wistrich has other clients in this category and is familiar with the Inquiry's work. Sara does not have the means to fund the legal representation which she requires to participate in the Inquiry. She satisfies the statutory test set out in rule 5(2)(b) of the Inquiry Rules 2006. I make a costs award in her favour under section 40(2) of the Inquiries Act 2005. The basis of assessment will be the same as that adopted in the case of Harriet Wistrich's other core participant clients in this category.
