

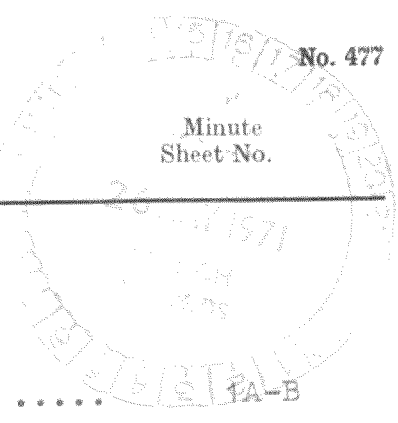

SUBJECT London
Sinn Fein

1. Submitted herewith is a booklet "Sinn Fein - Yesterday and Today", copies of which are currently being circulated in London Sinn Fein circles.

2. The booklet gives a Sinn Fein interpretation of the political history of Ireland since the founding of Sinn Fein in 1905. It claims that despite the good intentions of successive Irish governments they have all eventually capitulated to the domination of the English economy.

3. The usual Sinn Fein aims are propounded, namely:-

- (a) An All-Ireland Parliament and the rejection of "the right of any foreign people or government to legislate for Ireland", to be achieved through "contesting local and parliamentary elections north and south of the border".
- (b) The nationalisation of the currency, banks and key industries; state development of the natural resources; co-operatives in farming, industry and trade. The cessation of foreign speculation and a curb on the flow of capital into Ireland.
