1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Tuesday 23 May 1972 a meeting of the Committee of the Anti-Internment League took place (location not known). The following persons were present:-

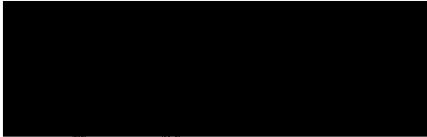
3. It was announced that Privacy had resigned from the Committee owing to pressure of other commitments.

4. On Saturday 24 June 1972 a demonstration, organised by the Anti-Internment League, has been planned to take place in Slough. The demonstration will commence at 3.30pm at Wellington Street, Slough and will take the form of a march through Slough shopping centre, past Eton College to Windsor where it will pass two army barracks and Windsor Castle. An open air rally at the end of the march will be addressed by Frank McMANUS, MP and James WRAY, father of one of the victims of 'Bloody Sunday'. At present three coaches have been organised to take members of the AIL from London to Slough. These coaches will travel from Hammersmith, Kilburn/Cricklewood and Camden.

5. A committee was set up to plan a campaign in defence of the "Free Area" in Northern Ireland. The members of this committee are as follows:-

6. To commemorate the anniversary of internment a week of activity from Saturday 5 August to Sunday 13 August 1972 is to be planned. These activities will include a demonstration in Glasgow on Saturday 5 August, and one in London on Sunday 13 August for which the use of Trafalgar Square is being sought.

7. **Privacy** has tendered his resignation as treasurer to the A.I.L. owing to pressure of work. He has been replaced by **Privacy** who is also to chair a committee on fund-raising, which consists of the following persons:-

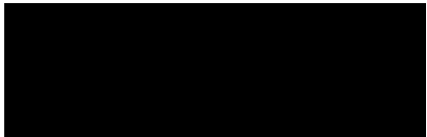
