International Marxist Group (I.M.G.)

The I.M.G. has been embarrassed by the activities of a small opposition group of militants in London and, although the leadership took disciplinary action against them in February, the rebels, numbering about fifteen, have now been joined by members of the Bristol branch. With a total membership of about 100, the I.M.G. depends for its success on penetration of other organisations and the Vietnam Solidarity Campaign (V.S.C.) has been its main interest. However, although the I.M.G. retained control of the V.S.C. in February, it has been unable to boost the falling morale of the Vietnam movement.
