2. "On Wednesday 15 September 1971, at the 'Tulse Hill Tavern' public house, Tulse Hill, SW2, a public meeting was held by the Lambeth branch of I S. The meeting, which began at 8.15pm and ended at 10pm was attended by about 30 people. The Chairman was Andy BUDDLE, the main speaker was John PALMER and the subject was the 'Dollar Crisis'.

3. PALMER gave a very detailed account on how the dollar had come under pressure and gave his assessment of how the United States would attempt to return the dollar to stability. His conclusion was that the whole issue was based on the 'Permanent Arms Economy' and as such the capitalist world could well resume the arms race to solve the present financial crisis; it may also prove to be the finale, i.e. atomic war.

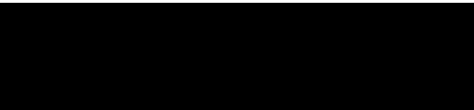
