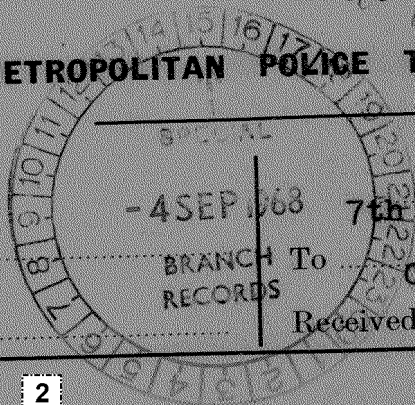

On 6th August 1968, between 8.30 p.m. and 10.45 p.m. I was present with W.D.C. **HN334** at a private meeting, attended by 70 persons, of International Socialism (Camden Branch), in a private room at the "Dublin Castle" public house, Parkway, N.W.1. At that meeting a request was made for as many members as possible to attend a march by strikers at Injection Moulders, Honeypot Lane, Kingsbury, which is due to take place at that factory at 6.30 p.m. on Thursday 8th August 1968, which is to be followed by a public meeting at Kingsbury Baths at 7.0 p.m.

Those unable to attend the above-mentioned meeting were urged to attend a demonstration at the Warner Cinema, Leicester Square, W.1, during a showing of the film "Green Beret" on Thursday 8th August, 1968, at 6.30 p.m. The speaker suggested that members should enter the cinema as ordinary film goers and demonstrate inside.
