On Saturday 25th May 1968 et 11.10am a telephone measage was received at Special Branch to the effect that members of the 'West London Group of the Vietnam Soliderity Campaign', the 'Black Power Movement' > and 'The Wednesday Group' were at 2.30pm assembling at Henekey's Public House, Portabello Roed, 3.11 with the intention of marching to Powis Square, W.11 to tear down the fencing surrounding it in order that the area could be used as a play space by local children.

In consequence of this message I went to Hendkey's Public Mouse at 2.00pm where demonstrstors were assembling under the suspices of the Rest London Group of the Vietnam Solidarity Campaign.


It is understood that originally a demonstration at Powis Square had been organised by Privacy and the Notting Hill Summer Project. which has its headquarters at 60 St Erwins Road, W.10. Privacy had arranged for local children to march around the private fenced green as a protest amainst it not being available as a playaround,

The V.S.G. demonstrators left Henekey's Public House at 2.20pm and hade their way along to Dis Square. They were to with the sid of a loud-topies wandering around the the Portabello Road to arnothingled by Privacy sceaker et to his march. He was assisted by Portspello ma Privacy who were presed up Privacy together as an ass, and Privacy who was dressed in a gorilla costume. After these arrests I was informed that the main organisers had all been detained, and this appeared to be t the case as the demonstrators lost their militant enthusiasm in spite of encouragement from Privacy

A shower of rain at 4.15pm. caused the demonstrators to disperse, and at 5pm the main body of uniformed Police withdrew.
