

Event Activities: None announced.

Remarks: The Social Court U.S.C. has headquarters at No. 1, Courty Gardens, S.W.5. A weekly outdoor meeting is held with a few regular supporters (about 12) in order to give rank and file members a chance to speak in public.

The main speaker on this occasion was [Privacy] and although he spoke for about an hour on Vietnam, Imperialism, and the exploitation of the working class, it was difficult to make sense of his speech.

CLARONEL praised the achievements of Mao, denounced American action in Vietnam as Imperialism, and spoke with enthusiasm of the revolt taking place in South America and in Africa against the capitalist system.

[Privacy] was something of a gate crasher, and was asked to speak by the Chairman in order to prevent him interrupting [Privacy] [Privacy] spoke briefly about racialism, but said nothing to any purpose.

It is worth noting that of the persons who showed the greatest interest in the meeting and stayed for the full two hours, about half were persons of colour and the remainder were M.A.D.I.S.T.s. Revisionist Communists and Trotskyists were not in evidence. The arguments from the platform did not seem to impress the majority of the persons present.
