1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The inaugural meeting of the North London Stop The Seventy Tour was held on Friday 17 April, 1970, from 8 pm until 10 pm at the School of Librarianship, North West Polytechnic, Essex Road, N1. It was attended by some 20 persons and the Chairman was **Privacy**."

3. The purpose of the meeting was to ascertain what support could be expected in the Camden, Islington and Hampstead areas for STST, and assuming that the necessary support was forthcoming, what lines the group should be run on.

4. **Privacy** explained the nature of STST to those present, and as its broad principles were acceptable, those present indicated that they would support the group. The remainder of the meeting, therefore, was devoted to the discussion of general plans prior to the arrival of the South Africans on June 1, i.e. leafletting, fly-posting, public meetings, etc. It was decided at the end, that a second meeting should be held at the same place and time on May 1, and that as much publicity as possible should be given to it in order to attract as many supporters as possible. It was also agreed that a small committee should meet on Monday 20 May to organise the group and its functions.
