Reference to Papers 346/70/9

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

"A meeting of the North West London Group of Stop The Seventy Tour was held at Friends Meeting House, Alexandra Grove, N12, on Tuesday, 21 April, 1970, from 8 pm until 10.30 pm. It was attended by some 20 persons; the Chairman was Privacy

The main purpose of the meeting was to discuss participation in the STST demonstration at Lords on Saturday, May 2nd. It was agreed that:

- (i) the main body of demonstrators would assemble at Lords at 10.30 am to distribute leaflets and picket the entrances to the ground.
(ii) a smaller body of demonstrators - those who had access to cars would meet at Wellington Place, NW8 to form a motorcade.
(iii) efforts should be made to conduct a 'Street Theatre' until 2 pm.

The following future events were also brought to the attention of those present:-

- (a) The North West STST are proposing to hold a public meeting on Wednesday, May 6th, 1970, at St. Michael's Church Hall, The Ridings, Mill at 7.30 pm. The Chairman would be Privacy, and it is hoped that the speakers will be Privacy, Peter Hall and Privacy.
(b) On Saturday, May 9th, 1970, a 'rave up' will be held at North Western Polytechnic, Kentish Town Road, NW5 at 7.30 pm, terminating at midnight.
