2. **Privacy** is the Secretary of the North West London Committee of the Stop the Seventy Tour.

3. She is currently living with her mother at **Privacy** and employed as a secretary at **Privacy**.

4. She is a close friend of **Privacy**, Chairman of the NW STST, but cannot be described as being "politically aware". She is, in fact, a somewhat immature, naive person and it would seem that she was made Secretary of the group because of her clerical experience.

5. It has been established that she intends to take up employment as a Probation Officer in **Privacy** in October 1970, and has just received confirmation of ~~that~~ appointment from Home Office.

6. Her description is as follows:-

Aged about 23 years; height 5'0"; short fair hair; slim build with well-developed bust; slightly Jewish appearance; often wears dark rimmed spectacles and has a slight cast in her left eye."
