"The North West London Group of the B.V.S.F. is showing an increasing interest in the current situation in Ireland, and all members are being encouraged to participate in Irish demonstrations whenever it is politically expedient to do so. In furtherance of these aims, two members of the North West London Group will participate in the demonstration being organised by the Irish Civil Rights Solidarity Campaign on Sunday, 20th July, 1969. On Monday, 21st July, 1969, members of the group will attend a meeting of the I.C.R.S.C. at the George public house, Angel, N.1. where the demonstration will be discussed."
