At a meeting of the Britain-Vietnam Solidarity Front held at 'The Union Tavern', Kings Cross Road, W.C.1. on Sunday 4th May, 1969, it was decided by Abhimanyu MANCHANDA, the general secretary, that B.V.S.F. should offer support to this demonstration.

The number of supporters of B.V.S.F. and allied Maoist factions likely to take part during the march and rally will not number more than 50 persons. It is expected that they will offer a vociferous contribution to the demonstration but there has been no suggestion that they will take any militant action.
