1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "On Sunday 13 February 1972, during the Rhodesian Emergency Campaign Committee's demonstration, Privacy of Privacy expressed interest in the Anti-Apartheid Movement. She stated she had recently arrived from Privacy where she had been actively engaged in extremist activities. She volunteered her services to enable her to get into the "swing of things" in this country."

3. There is no trace of Privacy in Special Branch Records. The AAM is the subject of 400/71/147; the Rhodesian Emergency Campaign Committee is the subject of 400/72/1.
