Sir,

I am directed by the Commissioner to inform you that the Vietnam Solidarity Campaign is organising a major demonstration to take place in London, on 27th October, 1968, and is making every effort to obtain support from all parts of Great Britain, particularly from students at colleges and universities. The indications are that the event could well be accompanied by large scale organised violence. Plans by the demonstrators are already in hand and reliable information has been received that coaches have been reserved in some areas to transport demonstrators to London.

I am to ask if you would kindly forward to this Branch any information your officers may be able to obtain concerning extremists or others who will attend from your area, in particular details of the coaches or other forms of transport they may use, numbers participating and times of departure for London.
