1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "A meeting of the Camden V.S.C. was held at 'The Laurel Tree' public house, Bayham Street, N.W.1. on Wednesday 8th October, 1969, from 8 p.m. to 11 p.m.

3. The meeting was chaired by Privacy and was attended by 21 persons. The major part of the meeting was taken up with discussion respecting the next issue of "Red Camden" and the proposed 'community centre' for which the group is currently searching for a suitable site.

4. Privacy criticised the group for failing to follow a more direct political line, but qualified his criticisms by acknowledging the fact that 'the left were groping in all directions at the present time for suitable subjects to tackle with concerted enthusiasm'.
