1. The following information has been received:-
2. "A meeting of Camden V.S.C. was held on Wednesday 1st October, 1969, at 'The Laurel Tree' public house, Bayham Street, N.W.1. from 8 p.m. to 11 p.m. There were 25 persons present.
3. The meeting was chaired by [REDACTED] Privacy and the majority of the evening was taken up with discussion centering around the weekend camp the group were holding at Coppice Camp, Kelvedon Hatch, Essex. The camp site apparently belongs to the Y.C.L. and it is thought that approximately 22 adults and 10 children will attend.
4. It was announced that the National V.S.C. intend to hold a delegates only meeting at 'The Dolphin' public house, Bidborough Street, W.C.1. on Monday 6th October, 1969, to discuss developments respecting the 'Mass Mobilisation' planned for November. No delegate was elected to attend from Camden V.S.C. due to a shortage of time for discussion of this topic at the end of the evening.
5. The remainder of the evening was taken with discussion, sometimes heated, regarding the 'lack of political direction' which the group is currently showing.
