1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "The National Committee of International Socialists have proposed that propaganda be published in a number of foreign languages in order to promote IS policies. This approach is not intended as a broad based appeal to the immigrant population but to create a faction within that community which will eventually propagate IS politics within immigrant communities and also educate overseas students in the principles of revolutionary socialism prior to their return home.

3. It is the intention of IS to bring these new members together for special cadre schools and a small conference of IS members concerned in immigrant work and members of the Immigrant Sub-Committee will be called to organise the programme."
