3. Although no definite plans for the future were made at the meeting, the following general points were concentrated upon in the discussion:-

- i. Trade Unions should be asked to withdraw any investments they have with firms connected with the Cabora Bassa Dam.
- ii. Local groups should be asked to picket any local firms who have any such connection with Cabora Bassa.
- iii. Attempts should be made to buy shares in Barclays DCO with a view to attending their AGM in late December or early January 1971.

4. In connection with point 3, it was suggested that there was "a person" in Richmond and Kingston Anti-Apartheid, who had a number of shares and who should be approached with a view to purchasing some of them.

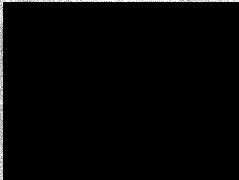
