1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Thursday, 12 November 1970 a meeting of the Dambusters Mobilising Committee was held between 7 pm and 9 pm at the Anti-Apartheid Offices, 89 Charlotte Street, W1. The Chairman was Christabel GURNEY and thirteen other persons were present.

3. Details were announced of proposed sit-ins to take place on Thursday, 26 November 1970 in protest against the Cabera Bassa Dam. The following buildings were designated as "targets":-

- a. Barclays DDO, Lombard Street, EC3 - by "Blackheath Commune".
- b. ICI, Millbank, SW1.
- c. GKN House, 22 Kingsway, WC2
- d. United Transport, Berkeley Square House, Berkeley Square, W1 - by University College.

Buildings (b) and (c) were not allotted to any particular protest group and this was left in abeyance. It was felt that lunchtime was the most opportune time, since this ensured the best support. However, it was acknowledged that support would be small and not entirely enthusiastic.

4. Christabel GURNEY announced that the Committee was solvent, and added that a donation of £50 had been received from Basil DAVISON. The next meeting was arranged for 3 pm on Sunday, 29 November 1970 at the Students Meeting House, 105 Gower Street, W1

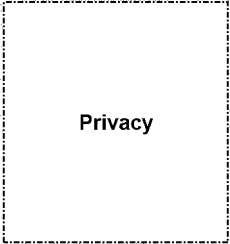

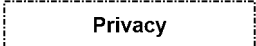
