The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

"On Sunday 29 November 1970, at the Students Meeting House, 105 Gower Street, W.C.1., a meeting was held under the auspices of the Dambusters Mobilising Committee. The meeting, which began at 3 p.m. and ended at 5.30 p.m. was attended by 8 persons.

The main purpose of the meeting was to discuss the sit-ins that had been held on 26 November against Barclays Bank, but this took very little time, and the meeting concentrated on future plans.

Privacy said that she had some "Friends of the (Portuguese) Liberation Struggle" visiting the U.K. from 5 to 8 December, whom she hoped to introduce to various contacts in this country, i.e. Labour Party, World Council of Churches etc. The visitors would be arriving at Heathrow Airport (no further details given).

In that connection, it was agreed that the Dambusters should hold a meeting at the L.S.E. on Friday 4 December, to meet

It was also decided to attempt to infiltrate Barclays Annual General Meeting (due to be held sometime in January), but no details were discussed.
