1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

On Wednesday 20 January 1971, at 89 Charlotte Street, W1, a meeting was held under the auspices of the Dambusters Mobilising Committee. The meeting, which began at 6.30 pm and ended at 8.15 pm, was attended by 10 persons. The Chairman was Privacy

The main item of discussion was a proposed 'day of action' against British Companies involved in the Cabera Basea project. The date arranged was 9 March 1971, and the firms suggested as possible targets were:- G.E.N.; I.C.I.; United Transport; Babcock and Wilcox; Alcan; Siemens. Research into the location of these firms would be carried out by the Committee, and further details would be discussed at the next meeting.

In the organisation of the Committee itself, it was decided to attempt to incorporate more groups than were currently involved in the campaign. Privacy said she would try to make contact again with the Trade Unions.
