1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. Privacy of Privacy gave a £1,000 cheque to the Anti-Internment League during December 1971. This money had been received by her from a former boy-friend - Privacy, the son of the late Privacy the film actor. Privacy Privacy

3. Privacy has been attending AIL and Irish Solidarity Campaign meetings during recent months as she is very concerned about the situation in Ireland. This led her to renew her contact with Privacy and to request his financial assistance, which resulted in the above cheque being sent to her for forwarding to the AIL.

4. Privacy is from Privacy and has been living in England for the past few years although she frequently changes her address in London and spends odd periods on the Continent. She also lived in Privacy for some six to nine months but disliked the country, which contributed to her split with Privacy.

5. She currently is unemployed, but when employed does mainly secretarial work.

6. Her description is:

Born about 1944; height 5'1", slim build, medium length Auburn hair, dresses fairly well but tries at times to look scruffy. Has only a very slight Privacy accent."

7. Privacy has come to the notice of Special Branch on four previous occasions. She attended Red Circle meetings on 16.11.71 and 30.11.71, and attended IIC meetings on 24.11.71 and 10.12.71. The Anti-Internment League is dealt with on 400/71/220. Privacy cannot be identified in Special Branch records.
