1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-
2. "A meeting of the North London Red Circle took place on 17.11.70 from 8 pm to 10.15 pm at 182 Pentonville Road, N1. There were 9 persons present.
3. The main topic was future Red Forums and the future role of the North London Red Circle. After a long discussion it was agreed to cancel Red Forum arranged for 8.12.70 since it clashed with the 'general' strikes. [REDACTED] Privacy would not now be asked to speak. It was also agreed the series of Red Forums would not be continued into 1971, but the NLRC would take greater interest in local activities, centred on Camden. [REDACTED] Privacy agreed to get particulars of the various organisations in Camden with which the NLRC could work.
4. [REDACTED] Privacy said that several members of the IUG and Spartacus League living in North West London were planning to start a NW London Red Circle. This would commence with a Red Forum on 29.11.70 in Kilburn High Road (exact location not given), the subject being "Repression of Black People".
5. [REDACTED] Privacy said that the Social on 5.12.70 would probably be a joint affair with the Black Defence Committee and any profits would go to that committee.

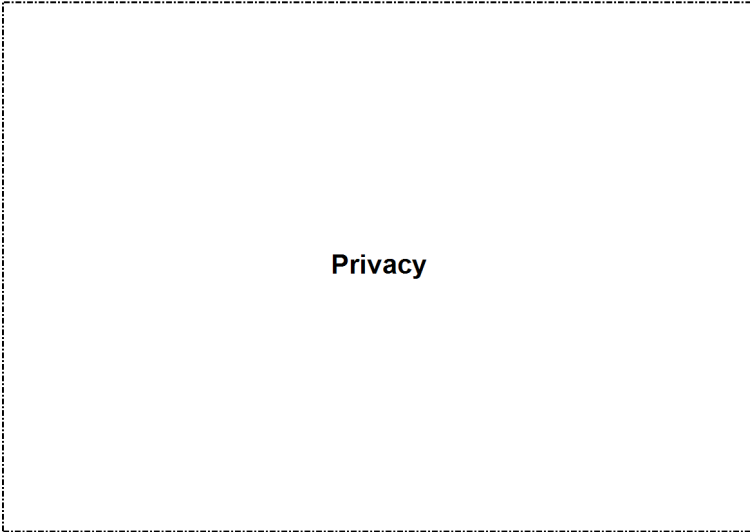

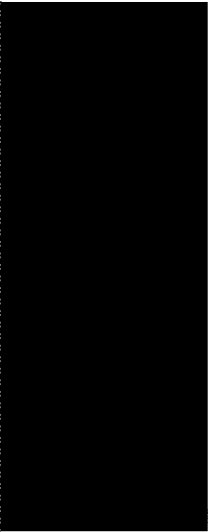
