North London Red Circle

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

A meeting of the North London Red Circle was held at the 'General Picton' PE Killick Street, W1, on 21.9.71 from 8.15 to 9.30 pm and there were 12 persons present.

Reference to Papers

100/77/70

The main part of the meeting was taken up with a talk by Privacy on 'British Capitalism'. This was a very uninspired talk and in fact did not evoke any response afterwards as regards questions or contributions. He spoke mainly on the relationship between British Capitalism and other European and American Capitalists after World War 2 and why British Capitalism suffered relatively more than the other leading Capital countries. The talk did not reveal interesting points.

2. After Privacy's talk Privacy (the organiser of the West London Red Circle) brought forth several suggestions regarding the running of the Red Circle. For instance, organising regular 'Red Mole' sales and attending meetings organised by other groups. His suggestions met with approval and those present were asked to give consideration to them and discuss it next week.

3. It was announced that the Notting Hill Spartacus League are organising a meeting at St. Mary's Church Hall, Blenheim Crescent W11, on 23.9.71 at 7.30 pm to discuss setting up an Angela DAVIS Defence Fund or some other suggestions for giving her and other American militants support."
