1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. For a while now the London organisers of the International Marxist Group have been attempting to recruit a Privacy a Notting Hill contact of the organisation. However, Privacy has apparently said he does not wish to join as he feels the leadership in Notting Hill is disorganised and yet dictatorial when the occasion suits. He has also accused IMG of being too bureaucratic and authoritarian in general. In particular he resents the attitude of Privacy

3. As a result the London organisers are calling a special meeting to discuss the matter, especially with Piers CORBYN the Notting Hill organiser. Meanwhile CORBYN has asked that he may be allowed to hold a cell meeting to debate the charges with local members."
