1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "There was a meeting of the Tower Hamlets Branch of the Independent Labour Party at 21, Barbanel House, Cephas Street, E.1., on Thursday 12th June, 1969, between 8.0 P.M. and 10.0 P.M. The persons present were: Privacy

3. The meeting consisted of a general discussion concerning the "increasing menace of fascism", and a talk by Privacy on the I.L.P. Summer School to be held at AYR, SCOTLAND, in July. It was proposed that Privacy of the Bexleyheath Branch of the I.L.P., be nominated as a candidate for the I.L.P. scholarship scheme, as this would entitle him to a free week at Ayr. It was announced that there would be a demonstration against a "fascist" rally to be held at Laurie Hall, Romford Market, Romford, Essex, on Monday 16th June, 1969. The wording of a leaflet concerning a local rent struggle against the council were finalised and it was stated that 1,000 copies would be printed by Privacy on his own duplicator, and distributed to selected blocks of flats in Tower Hamlets on Thursday, 19th June, 1969."

4. Privacy (phonetic) cannot be identified in Special Branch records. Her description is:-
