1. The following information was received from a reliable source:

2. Privacy aged about 20 years, of Privacy is a member of the INDEPENDENT LABOUR PARTY and has recently been canvassing support in the vicinity of his home with a view to forming a Branch of the organisation in that area. He is known to have been an ardent supporter of extreme left-wing politics for some time and to have attended numerous demonstrations in the London area."

3. Privacy was amongst those persons who took part in the disorderly demonstration organised by the IRISH CIVIL RIGHTS SOLIDARITY CAMPAIGN outside the Ulster Office, Berkeley Street, W.1. on Sunday 17th August, 1969, when he was seen to be on friendly terms with Privacy and other Anarchists.

4. Previously, on Sunday 20th July, 1969, he took part in a demonstration organised by I.C.R.S.C. outside the Ulster Office, Berkeley Street, W.1. but on that occasion he was wrongly identified as Privacy Secretary of the Poplar Branch of I.L.P." A photograph of him taken on that occasion which is a good likeness is attached.

His description is as follows:-

Aged about 20 years, 5'9", stocky build, long straight brown hair, comp. pale, round face, wears horn-rimmed spectacles.
