1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

"On Tuesday, 8 September 1970, between 8 pm and 10 pm at 10 Tomlins Grove, Poplar, E3, a meeting of the Tower Hamlets Branch of the Independent Labour Party was held. The chairman was Privacy and two other persons were present - Privacy and Privacy

Privacy resigned as secretary of the branch, and Privacy was elected in his place. The new branch chairman was to be Privacy

It was announced that the National Administrative Council of the Independent Labour Party were to hold a Special Conference, in Leeds, at the end of October. This was expected to produce a 'showdown' between the militants and moderates of the I.L.P., with the moderates hoping to dissuade the extremist fringe from remaining in the party, by introducing totally unacceptable policies. Privacy was to be the Tower Hamlets branch delegate for the conference."

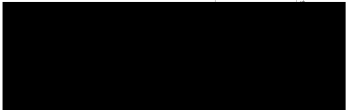
