Women's Union

The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

1. From 7.30 pm to midnight on Thursday 2 March 1972, the Executive Committee of the Revolutionary Women's Union held a meeting at [Privacy] The following persons were present:-

2. The meeting had been called to discuss the disruptive tactics of [Privacy] and [Privacy]. There were lengthy discussions on the various incidents that had occurred in the organisation recently which had involved [Privacy] and a written list of these incidents was compiled. It was intended to confront [Privacy] with the list at the next meeting of the Revolutionary Women's Union (Monday 5 March 1972). If she continued to be disruptive (in the eyes of the executive committee) she would then be suspended from the organisation.

3. The forthcoming Women's Liberation National conference was the next item. The conference had been planned initially for the 18/19 March 1972 at Manchester University, but it had now been put back to 25/26 March at the same venue.

4. There was some discussion on the proposed Nursery Campaign and a public meeting was provisionally arranged for 23.3.72 at the Islington Library, Essex Road, N1.

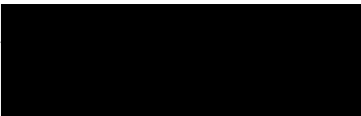

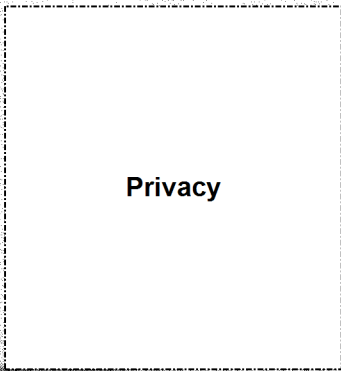
