1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Wednesday 15 December 1977, the London Region of the W.L.C.C. held a meeting at the Hole in the Wall, Rochester Road, E15. There were approximately 15 London Women's Liberation groups represented, some seven of whom were closely connected with the Gay Liberation Front.

3. The meeting was chaired by a woman from one of the G.L.F. groups (this woman organised the protest against the strip show at a miners' evening during the recent National Conference). She was extremely anti-men and anti-Naziist.

4. Eight delegates were elected to represent the London region at the conference to be held in Bristol on 8.1.78 to organise a national conference for March 1978. The eight included

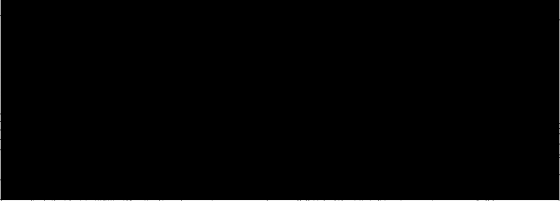
