1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. On Tuesday 18 April 1972, at 89 Charlotte Street, 21, the Anti-Apartheid Movement held an executive meeting. It commenced at 7.30 pm and terminated at 10 pm; there were eight persons present. Apologies were received from Peter HILLYER and Tony O'DONN.

3. Among the items on the agenda the following were discussed at length (1) involvement of trade unions (2) a boycott campaign of South African goods (3) Pearce Commission.

4. It had been learned that the Pearce Commission report was not expected to be published until late May or early June. In view of this it was agreed to organise interim activity to retain the public interest. However, nothing specific was arranged and the next meeting of the executive committee fixed for Tuesday 3 May 1972.
