Privacy of the Camden Branch Irish Civil Rights Solidarity Campaign who attended the Steering Committee meeting held at the "Dolphin" Public House on Tuesday 2nd December, 1969, pointed out to other members of the Committee that Privacy the treasurer of Camden Branch of I.C.R.S.C., may well be a member of the National Front. The reason for his allegation was that when Privacy first went to the Camden Branch he was in the company of two known and admitted members of the National Front. He was challenged about his association with these two men later and said that they were friends of his, but that he was unaware of the fact that they were members of the National Front. His answer was accepted and he had remained an active member of the Camden Branch. When Privacy gave this information to other members of the Committee, however, they demanded that if and when Privacy next attended a Steering Committee he should be challenged about his association with the National Front."
