1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "A meeting of the North London Red Circle took place on 5.1.71 at 182 Pentonville Road, N1, from 8 pm to 9.30 pm and was attended by 14 persons.

3. Most of the meeting was taken up with a talk by Gery LAWLESS on Ireland. He concentrated on showing the similarity between the present day situation with the period between 1916 and 1922. There were only a few questions from those present plus a short contribution from Privacy. However, nothing of particular interest to Special Branch was said.

It was agreed that there would be no meeting on Tuesday, 12.1.71, but that members should make an effort to attend any meetings or demonstrations supported by the IMG in connection with the proposed one day strike. No details were given of any such meetings other than a vague reference to a meeting in Hyde Park at 2.30 pm.

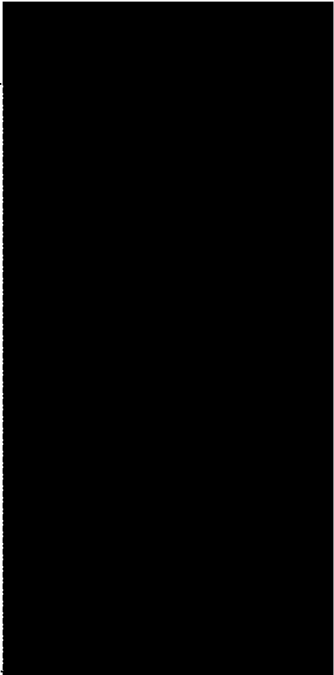
