- The following information has been received from a reliable source:
- "A meeting of the North London Red Circle was held at the 'General Fiction' 38, Millick Street, N1 on 28.3.72 from 8.45 pm to 10.00 pm. There were about 20 persons present.
- The subject for discussion should have been 'Cuba' but the speaker did not arrive. Therefore Privacy, who had simply called in at the 'General Fiction' on his way home, stood in and gave a brief talk on Ireland. As he had nothing prepared he only gave a sketchy outline of the background to the present situation. A few questions ensued but they were of no particular interest. The proceedings soon lapsed into a cross talk in French between the French comrades present - of which there were about eight. The only point which aroused any interest was a short discussion about the 26.3.72 demonstration. Several of the French comrades could not understand why an attack had not been made against the police in order to enter Trafalgar Square to hold a meeting there. It was explained there would have been insufficient support for such action and as such would have been doomed to failure.
