1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

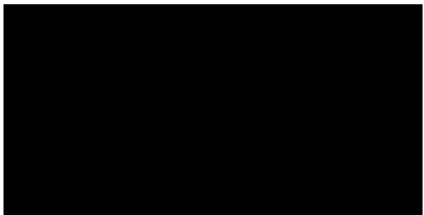
2. On 18.4.72 a meeting of the North London Red Circle was held at the 'General Picton' PH, Killick Street, N1 from 8.30 to 10pm.

3. The main part of the meeting was devoted to a talk by Pat JORDAN on 'The Russian Revolution'. He gave a historical account of the events up to the October 1917 Revolution. He then told how Stalin had betrayed the revolution by moving away from the original principles of Leninism which had resulted in Russia becoming a bureaucratic state. The main points in his talk were aimed in two predictable directions -condemnation of Stalin and praise of Trotsky.

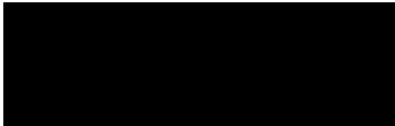
