

- 4.12.71 Caucus Tenants meeting. Privacy
- 7.12.71 Further discussion on the drafts submitted for a letter to be sent to all WNGC groups.
- 9.12.71 WLF meeting cancelled - members to attend a meeting at Holborn Central Library, where Joshua HALL author of "Away with all posts", would speak on his recent visit to China.
- 16.12.71 A discussion and revue of the Constitution and Aims of the WLF in preparation for the AGM.
- 30.1.72 Provisional date for the AGM.

4. There then followed a long discussion on the research in nurseries. Privacy felt the WLF should concentrate on an area in and around North and South Hackney and work in conjunction with the Tenants Associations. This suggestion was agreed upon. It was agreed that Privacy would write to Privacy a journalist from the 'Morning Star', who was involved in a NURSERY campaign. Privacy mentioned that whilst Privacy had been in London, she had made enquiries into conditions at a home for unmarried school-girls and their babies at Fortis Green Road, N2. The matron had welcomed a visit and as a result a team from the WLF would make arrangements to visit the home.

5. There then followed a long discussion on the London Alliance. Privacy announced that a tribunal was being set up to investigate "increasing police brutality" and in particular, "the murder of prisoners in Police stations" in the North London area. This would involve members of the LA visiting relatives and friends of the deceased and the gathering of data. The LA would continue to picket the courts where members were being tried. She urged members of the WLF to become involved with the LA. She stated that early in January the Irish National Liberation Solidarity Front would be holding a torch-light procession through Islington in which wreaths would be placed on the spot where Stephen MacCarthy had been "murdered". WLF members were asked to contribute towards a wreath.
