2. "From 7.30 pm to 10 pm on Wednesday 6 October 1971 the Women's Liberation Front held a meeting at Privacy. The meeting was attended by ten persons of whom the following were identified:

Privacy opened with a statement regarding the next issue of "Women's Liberation" which she is producing together with Privacy and Privacy. Articles for publication had now been prepared for the printer and the paper would be ready for distribution on Wednesday 13 October.

3. The remainder of the evening was devoted to a discussion on the WLF paper to be submitted to the Women's National Conference on 16/17 October at Skegness.

4. Privacy announced that the NLA would be having a meeting at the Laurel Tree public house at 1.30 pm on Friday 8 October 1971. The next WLF meeting would be held at Privacy on Thursday 14.10.71.

5. In closing it was announced that the WLF would attend the Angela DAVIES Defence Committee meeting at Central Hall, Westminster on Wednesday 13.10.71 to distribute copies of 'Women's Liberation'.
