3. Privacy who chaired the meeting, opened the discussions on the current development of the nursery campaign which had started three weeks previously. She urged members to take a more active part in the campaign. Several volunteered to help in leaflet distribution and to assist in gaining signatures for a petition. It was accepted that the petition would do little towards gaining council organised nursery facilities but it would serve as a means of gaining contact with working class women. It would encourage such women to participate in other forms of action, such as attending meetings and supporting demonstrations and pickets etc.

4. Privacy next suggested that the RWU should bring out a newspaper and this idea was supported; each member volunteered to write an article for it. Privacy also mentioned that the North London Alliance were currently involved in producing their newspaper 'Class War'.

5. From 9.30 pm until the meeting closed at 10.45 pm there was a study session taken from a document - 'Lenin in Conversation with Clara Zetkin.'
