3. The meeting was chaired by Privacy who opened the discussion. She announced there would be a National Women's Conference at the Students Union, Queens Road, Bristol on 9 and 10 September 1972. The main subjects at that conference would be the Contraception and Abortion Campaigns. The line that the RWU would take was debated and it was decided there would be opposition to the anti-pollution aspect of the Contraception and Abortion Campaigns but support for the Socialist case in support of the campaign. It was decided three members would attend the conference so that as many contacts as possible could be established with other groups.

4. There then followed a lengthy discussion on the assembly and arrangement of the next RWU magazine which would be entitled 'Womens Voice'.
