1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Monday, 2 October 1972, the Revolutionary Women's Union held a meeting at Privacy between 7 pm and 10.30 pm. The following persons were present:-

3. The meeting dealt mainly with the contents of their most recent issue of 'Women's Voice' and the prospects of printing a second edition. Sales of the magazine had been extremely good by RWU standards with 400 copies at 3p each having been sold.

4. Privacy read a leaflet from the Women's group organising the next Women's Liberation conference. The letter outlined final details for the conference and called on all groups to make some financial contribution as the Women's Liberation Workshop had no funds whatsoever.

5. Privacy was not present as she was attending a celebration evening at the Chinese Embassy with her husband to commemorate the 1st October.

6. The meeting also arranged that members should participate in weekend magazine selling and signature collecting for the nursery petition."
