1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-
2. "On Monday, 20 November 1972, the Revolutionary Women's Union held its weekly meeting at Privacy The meeting was held between 7.30 pm and midnight.
3. The greater part of the evening was taken up with the study of a Socialist Women's document which had been produced by an American Womens Liberation Group. There was little discussion and the document was simply read aloud by different members.
4. The forthcoming Chinese exhibition (previously reported) was discussed and members were asked to give their assistance and support to the function.
5. There was much general debate of the current economic situation and poor housing facilities. It emerged that members of the North London Alliance were spending more and more time in the Stratford and West Ham areas, selling their magazines and distributing leaflets. Members of the RWU were encouraged to help with this work.

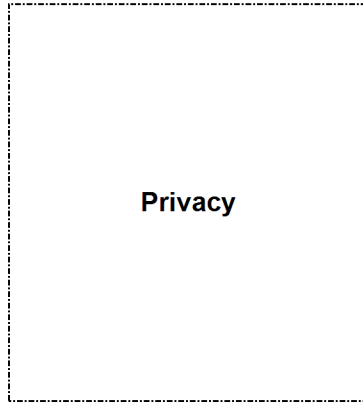
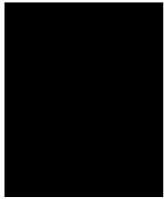
