"On Monday, 16th December 1968, the Earls Court Britain-Vietnam Solidarity Front held a Committee meeting at 251, Cromwell Road, S.W.5. The chairman was [Redacted] Privacy and other persons present were:

The meeting opened with a brief report on the demonstration on Saturday, 14th December 1968 against police brutality, which, it was agreed, was worthwhile although poorly attended.

Until the meeting was closed at 10.30pm discussion took place on various innocuous subjects none of which was of interest to Special Branch."
